2026/2027 ADMISSIONS SCREENING EXERCISE

This is to inform all UTME candidates who applied for admission to **University of Fortune, Igbotako, Ondo State** for the 2026/2027 academic session that registration for Post-UTME admission screening exercise is now on-going, effective from **Monday, 22nd June, 2026**.

Candidates eligible for the screening exercise:

- Those who made **University of Fortune, Igbotako (UF)** their institution of First choice in the 2026/2027 UTME and scored 150 and above;
- Those who sat for the 2026/2027 UTME, scored 150 and above and are willing to change and make **University of Fortune, Igbotako (UF)** their institution of First choice.

Note: Candidates who did not make **UF** their institution of **first choice** initially, but are willing to choose **UF** should make the necessary change of institution on JAMB CAPS to **UF** before the close of registration for the screening exercise. **All eligible candidates, who should not be less than 16 years by September 30, 2026**, are to visit the **University website www.fortune.edu.ng** to register for the screening as from **Monday, 22nd June, 2026**. After making a payment of **N2,000** (two thousand Naira) only for **POST-UTME REGISTRATION**. Payment should be made only to the following University's Account:

Guidelines to Candidates for Online Registration:

- Visit www.fortune.edu.ng
- Create an account with valid JAMB registration number and e-mail address;
- Confirm your e-mail address by clicking on the link sent to your e-mail (check spam box, if not found in your e-mail inbox);
- Log in and make payment of **N2,000.00 (for POST-UTME REGISTRATION)** using the account details above;
- After successful payment, candidates are to fill their bio-data with valid details; and,
- Print out bio-data slip.

General Instructions to all Candidates

- Candidates are advised to correctly upload all their O'Level results on the portal. A maximum of two (2) sittings is allowed in the case of O'Level requirements.
- UOF accepts WAEC, NECO and NABTEB O'Level results.
- Candidates awaiting O'Level results may also apply but must upload their results on both the University portal and JAMB CAPS as soon as they are released for seamless admission processing.
- Candidates are to click on **Admission Requirements** to check for O'Level and UTME subject requirements for the respective courses of choice.
- Candidates who did not comply with the UTME subject combination are requested to change to their desirable courses on JAMB CAPS.
- Candidates are advised to read the O'Level requirements of their courses and select the right subject combinations, which must include Credit pass in **English Language** for all courses in UF.
- Candidates should ensure that the online form is carefully completed, following **ALL** necessary instructions, as "mistake(s)" may be seen as misrepresentation/falsification, which shall lead to disqualification.
- Candidates are to then print out evidence of completion of transaction and keep for future reference.
- It is compulsory for all candidates to participate in the online screening exercise to qualify them for consideration for admission by the University.

SPECIAL NOTICE TO PROSPECTIVE APPLICANTS

- The registration for the online screening exercise commences on **Monday, 22nd June, 2026**.
- Candidates are advised to study the attached documents to ascertain the minimum 2026 UTME Scores required for the advertised programmes and ensure proper guidance during application.
- Candidates are advised to provide valid and active e-mail addresses and phone numbers (without "DO NOT DISTURB"). The University will not take responsibility for failure to get information as a result of invalid e-mail address and non-functional phone numbers.
